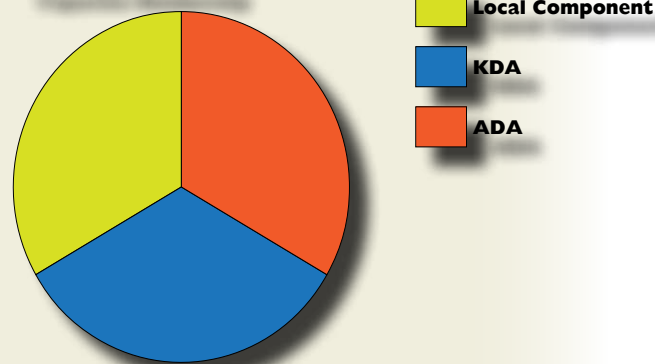
Meetings:

Executive Board meetings may be called at any time by the Board's Chairperson. The Board generally meets four times per year. KDA Annual Session is a four day meeting in Louisville in March. ADA Annual meeting is a five day meeting in October.

Membership:

There are approximately 1,500 members who are solo practitioners, group practitioners or academicians. KDA members also belong to the ADA and their component societies, which completes the tripartite membership. We have a very committed volunteer base with whom it is exciting to work. The Executive Board is committed to strategic thinking and best association practices.

Legislative Activities:

The Executive Director assists our contract lobbyists in monitoring all legislative activities that may impact the practice of dentistry. Testimony before legislative committees is often necessary.
