ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

PREREQUISITE COURSES

- General Chemistry I & II with labs (8 hours)
- Organic Chemistry I & II with labs (8 hours)
- General Physics (3 hours minimum)
- Biochemistry (3 hours minimum)
- Biology (16 hours minimum); strongly recommended upper level biology courses:
 - Human Anatomy
 - Microbiology
 - Human Physiology
 - Histology
 - Cellular Molecular Biology
 - Immunology
 - Intermediary Metabolism

DENTAL ADMISSIONS TEST (DAT)

- Scores must be less than two years old

RECOMMENDATION LETTERS

- 3 letters OR 1 pre-professional school committee evaluation

SHADOWING

- 40-100 hours of shadowing or working in general dentistry practices
- Other personal accomplishments such as honors, community service, research and work experience also are evaluated
